Additionally, we are in need of a coordinator for these rides. 6.2 2*: RJ reported that the rides are well-attended, with recent cancellations occurring only due to weather conditions. There is a large number of ride leaders, making it easy to share responsibilities. Attendance is very good, and it may be necessary to split the rides to accommodate everyone. The RidewithGPS training which took place in November was successful, with around 14 participants. We may consider repeating this training in the future. 6.3 3*: Recruiting leaders remains a challenge, and the number of riders is currently low. We will attempt to run 2/3star rides to attract new participants. 6.4 4-star rides: The rides are typically organized last minute, with around 4-6 riders attending each time. 7. **Tours & weekends:** 7.1 Multiple tours are planned for this year, including destinations such as Bavaria, Wessex, BRA in France, and Lancashire. 7.2 The Lancashire tour is fully booked, and the Wessex tour is also very popular.
